Seeking a Restoration Ecologist



San Diego Canyonlands (SDCL) is a growing non-profit dedicated to restoring and preserving San Diego County's wonderful canyons and creeks. SDCL is seeking a **Restoration Ecologist** to support SDCL programs primarily throughout San Diego County. The Restoration Ecologist is mainly responsible for vegetation assessment and community classification, habitat restoration planning and subsequent implementation. Conducts project monitoring and reporting as needed. Supports community organizing and canyon-event activities to implement restoration plans and otherwise affect the development and ongoing accomplishment of SDCL's objectives and goals. This job will include implementation of SDCL's Canyon Enhancement Planning and Canyon Stewardship/Restoration plans and programs including: volunteer event facilitation, trail building, supporting SDCL community organizing goals, grant writing, and supervising staff, interns, and volunteers as needed.

Skill Sets and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in Biology or a closely related field with appropriate areas of study to understand San Diego's local floral and faunal relationships is required.
- Sufficient local field experience in identification of flora or fauna, including endangered species status and trends, experience in habitat evaluation, and familiarity with suitable mitigation methods including revegetation design and implementation is required.
- Qualified Herbicide Application License (QAL) and state certified herbicide applicator is preferred.
- Focused species survey capabilities (primarily California Gnatcatcher song birds) meeting agency qualifications/certifications and regulatory protocol requirements, and possess or obtains appropriate permits is preferred, but not required.
- Experience with GIS Mapping and gathering and mapping conditions data in the field including vegetation communities etc. is preferred, but not required.
- Experience with Wetland Delineation is preferred, but not required.
