Seeking a Habitat Restoration Technician



San Diego Canyonlands (SDCL) is a growing non-profit dedicated to restoring and preserving San Diego County's wonderful canyons and creeks. SDCL is seeking a **full time Habitat Restoration Technician** to join our team. Primary tasks will include: volunteer event facilitation, invasive plant removal, planting, watering, trail maintenance, tools maintenance, graffiti paint-out, flyer delivery, trash and debris removal, reporting on progress, and administrative duties.

Administrative duties include volunteer participation reporting and database entry. This position also conducts outreach, recruits and trains volunteers and works with volunteer leaders and the public to coordinate events.

Skill Sets and Experience

- A Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience is required.
- Availability on Saturdays to stage, implement and coordinate volunteer events is required.
- Knowledge of San Diego's native flora & fauna required.
- Proficiency in the use of Microsoft Office Suite (Excel, Word, PowerPoint, etc.) is required.
- Experience with database entry (Salesforce) is preferred, but not required.
- QAL or QAC herbicide applicator license is preferred, but not required.
- GIS knowledge and skills are preferred, but not required.

- Experience in landscaping and using landscaping tools is preferred, but not required.
